What is CASI?

CASI's full form is council of allied science of India.

■ When was CASI established?

CASI was established in 2006 and CASI is incorporated by MCA, Govt. of India.

Is the CASI approved by Govt.?

Yes, it is in corporated by Govt. of India.

What is aim of CASI?

Aim of CASI is to fulfill the requirements for staff of the paramedical field.

Are you approved by MCI?

CASI has no need of MCI approval one council cannot approve to another council and CASI offers paramedical allied courses not medical.

↓ Is student getting registered under paramedical council?

Yes, student can get registration under Paramedical Council as per state policy.

↓ Is the CASI programme is valid in Govt./Pvt./Public undertaking?

Yes, all programmes offered by CASI are valid for all sector jobs and it depends on employer.

CASI is valid for higher studies?

Yes. It is valid for higher studies.

Can student go abroad after getting CASI diploma?

Yes, they can go abroad. Many students are already working in abroad like Dubai, UAE and Canada.

From where student can get practical training of paramedical courses?

Student can get practical training in hospital / path lab & their study centre.

Is CASI working in India only?

Yes, CASI is working in India only.

What is the age limit to get admission?

Age limit for taking admission in CASI is 45years.

Where is CASI conducting exam?

Exam conduct in their study centre or any Govt. /Private school or it can be online mode also.

Is CASI following Examination pattern annual or semester mode?

Exam will be conducting in Annual mode only.

How student can get admission?

Student can apply for admission through website or contact to nearest study centre for which is list available on website.

What is the duration of the courses?

CASI offering certificate and diploma programme, which duration is 1year, 2 years, 3 years.

What is the other fees CASI charging despite the course fees?

CASI is charging other fees for:-

- Exam fee is 1000 per year
- Admission fees is 1000 one time
- Migration 1000
- Bonafied -1000
- Final certificate –1000
- Provisional -1000

Is internship mandatory if yes, then what duration?

Yes, it is mandatory and duration depends on the course (kindly check syllabus for more syllabuses)

There are 5 types of membership that CASI offers:-

- 1. Technical membership
- 2. Academic membership
- 3. Council membership
- 4. Professional membership
- 5. Corporate membership

Who can apply for corporate membership?

Any organisation/institute/ partnership firm/ society working in the Paramedical field and must have minimum 3 years' experience.

When application open for membership?

Application open time to time for membership or it will be decided by the Patron member of council.

Who can become the academic member?

The person who has the master degree in medical /paramedical field and 5 year Experience in field. That person can apply for academic membership.

Any organisation/ institute / paramedical firm /society working in the Paramedical field & have minimum three years' experience.
